How to get started?

Four steps for easy and secure password storage

What is a password manager?

It is a database where individual passwords and usernames are stored. The password manager is logged in via **the master password**, which should be really strong because it protects all other passwords and data. The password manager also offers the generation of new passwords and **browser extensions**. It is also available for **mobile devices**.

1

On the **Keepassxc.org** website, click on the **Download** tab and choose the version for your operating system.

2

After selecting the version for your operating system, download the KeepassXC **installation file** to your device. The file can be in **EXE** format (for Windows) or **DMG** format (for macOS), or you may need to install from a **repository** (for Linux).

3

Run the downloaded **installation file** and follow the on-screen instructions.

4

Once the installation is complete, you can start KeepassXC from **the applications menu** (Start menu on Windows, Launchpad on macOS).

After the first launch, you will be able to **create a new** password database or **import** an existing one, and start using KeepassXC to manage your passwords.
